

Declaration
regarding the

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006
of the European Parliament and the Council
for registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemical
substances (REACH)

REACH sets requirements for manufacturers, importers and fabricators of substances, preparations and / or products within the meaning of the regulation and requires intensive communication between fabricators and suppliers.

In this REACH regulation, Arula GmbH is obliged to register as a downstream user. In our company we have dealt thoroughly with the REACH regulation. We only use dyeing and finishing products that comply with the REACH regulation and that are registered with REACH.

Arula products are not subject to the conditions set out in Article 33 for the requirements for consumer registration, as no chemicals for dyeing and finishing under the SVHC category are used. We therefore ensure that our products comply with the actual status of the REACH regulation.

Our upstream suppliers confirm that their products do not have any constitutional constituents of more than 0.1% in regards to the current valid candidate list of the "Substances of Very High Concern" placed by the "European Chemicals Agency" or the currently applicable annexes to the regulation 1907/2006 / EC (REACH).

Our relevant suppliers are obliged to inform us after any publication of an updated ECHA candidate list and to check the substances supplied to us with regard to this list.

We assure that we comply with our REACH conformity obligations and that our customers will be informed immediately if our product's assessment of SVHC substances changes.

This declaration is based on the list of candidates from January 23th, 2024.
