

Declaration
on
Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006
Of the European Parliament and of the Council
on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals
(REACH)

REACH imposes requirements on manufacturers, importers, and downstream users of substances, mixtures and/or articles within the meaning of the regulation and requires intensive communication between processors and suppliers.

Under this REACH regulation, Arula GmbH is subject to registration as a downstream user. Within our company, we have thoroughly addressed the REACH regulation. We only use dyeing and finishing products that comply with the REACH regulation and are REACH registered.


Arula products are not subject to the conditions outlined in Article 33 regarding consumer notification requirements, as no chemicals from the SVHC category are used in our dyeing and finishing processes. Therefore, we ensure that our products fully comply with the current status of the REACH regulation.

Our upstream suppliers confirm that their products do not contain any constituents in concentrations above 0.1% that have been placed on the currently valid Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern by the European Chemicals Agency or included in the currently applicable annexes of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH). Our relevant suppliers are obligated to inform us after each publication of an updated candidate list by ECHA and to review the substances they supply to us with regard to this list.

We assure that we are fulfilling our REACH compliance obligations and that our customers will be promptly informed in the event of any change in the assessment of our products with regard to SVHC substances. We hereby confirm that we have fulfilled our due diligence obligations to the best of our ability as an SME.

This declaration is based on the Candidate List from the 1st quarter of 2025.
