

Declaration
regarding
Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006
of the European Parliament and of the Council
concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of
Chemicals (REACH)

REACH sets requirements for manufacturers, importers and downstream users of substances, preparations and/or articles within the meaning of the Regulation and requires close communication between processors and suppliers.

Under the REACH Regulation, Arula GmbH is subject to registration obligations as a downstream user. Within our company, we have thoroughly familiarised ourselves with the requirements of the REACH Regulation. We use only dyeing and finishing products that comply with the REACH Regulation and are duly registered under REACH.

Products manufactured by Arula are not subject to the requirements set out in Article 33 regarding consumer notification, as no chemicals belonging to the SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) category are used in the dyeing and finishing processes. We therefore ensure that our products comply with the current status of the REACH Regulation.

Our upstream suppliers confirm that their products do not contain any constituent substances in concentrations exceeding 0.1% that have been included by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in the currently valid Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern or listed in the applicable annexes of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH). Our relevant suppliers are obliged to inform us after each publication of an updated ECHA Candidate List and to verify the substances supplied to us against this list.

We hereby confirm that we fulfil our obligations regarding REACH compliance and that our customers will be informed immediately in the event of any change in the assessment of our products with regard to SVHC substances.

This declaration is based on the Candidate List dated 16 September 2025.
